ACT

To amend the Repeal of the Black Administration Act and Amendment of Certain Laws Act, 2005, so as to substitute a date; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

Amendment of section 1 of Act 28 of 2005, as amended by section 1 of Act 8 of 2006 and section 1 of Act 13 of 2007

1. Section 1 of the Repeal of the Black Administration Act and Amendment of Certain Laws Act, 2005, is hereby amended by the substitution in subsection (3) for paragraph (a) of the following paragraph:

“(a) **[30 June 2008]** 30 December 2009; or”.

Short title and commencement

2. This Act is called the Repeal of the Black Administration Act and Amendment of Certain Laws Amendment Act, 2008, and comes into operation on 29 June 2008.
